

EXCLUSIVE VEHICLE TIPS FOR

OPERATION HASTINGS



PBR

All of the bases in Operation Hastings are on the rivers, so the PBRs are critical to the U.S. team. You can achieve an early foothold by taking a fully loaded PBR south to the bases at C,4 and C,5 (one may already be under U.S. control by the time you arrive). Sweep the shores with your machine guns as you cruise, but don't even try to tangle with an N.V.A. PT-76. It will blow you out of the water, and you don't have a gun big enough to cause a dent. After clearing enemy troops from the waterline, take your squad ashore and secure the base.



PT-76

The N.V.A. PT-76 is the baddest vehicle in Operation Hastings, especially when you roam the waterways. Target U.S. PBRs and other enemy vehicles on land as you patrol the delta. If you are in the water, stay in the middle of the river to avoid enemy rocket launchers on the shore.



BTR-60

Although lacking the armor and firepower of a PT-76, the BTR-60 is watertight and mobile, and its roof-mounted machine gun can take down enemy ground troops, PBRs and even helicopters. If you can coax a squad to occupy the vehicle, you can disembark with a substantial force when you exit the water near a U.S. base. However, rocket launchers are your worst enemy, so be sure to clear the shoreline before you leave the water.
